## A Few CC&R Reminders:

As we are coming into Spring, please keep in mind these simple CC&R Reminders to keep our neighborhood clean and beautiful...

### Un sightliness and Maintenance of Property

Properties in Shenandoah West shall be kept clean, safe, attractive and in good repair. Weeds, debris, and building materials are to be removed or stored out of sight at all times. Please remove all hazardous and dead trees.

**Trash, recycling, & compost** cans must be stored out of view, at all times. They should be set out no sooner than the night before trash pickup and should be removed on the day of pickup. Any garbage that is visible, either from the front of your home or from the park, should be removed as soon as possible.

**Trailers, RV's, Boats, and all other outdoor recreation or work equipment** are to be stored and screened from view at all times. The board allows up to **48 hours** to load and unload recreational equipment and then it must be moved off-site or out of view.

**While walking your dogs** they must be kept on a leash at all times. **Please pick up after your dog as well, we have had many complaints about dog poop in people's yards and on our sidewalks.**

***All exterior changes must go through the Board.***

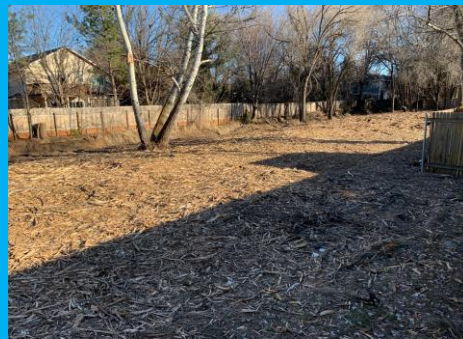
## IN THE KNOW
