## Winter Safety and CC&R Reminders

- Christmas and Holiday Lights are allowed in the neighborhood between November 24<sup>th</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 2. The sidewalks and community walking areas should be free from snow and ice to prevent trips and slips. If you have a neighbor who cannot shovel, ask to help!
- Drive slowly and safely when freezing temperatures are observed or expected. Neighborhoods and parking lots offer the largest risk for pedestrian safety.
- 4. Bring your pets inside whenever possible they too can get cold. When you are gone during the day, try giving them a warm place to retreat to, like a garage or a pet house.
