### *New Organization of the Board*

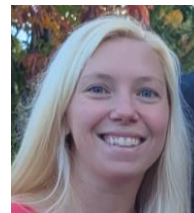
#### **President: Deena Merrill-Reagle**

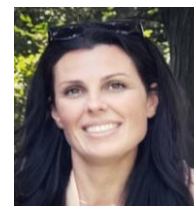
#### **Treasurer: Michael Garza**

## Did you know?

☆ **Shoveling Snow is a Boise City Code Requirement?** Ordinance Section 7-5-5: “Every owner of any building or vacant lot...shall, during the time snow shall be on the ground, by 9:00 A.M. every morning, when necessary, clear the sidewalks and gutters in front of his property from snow, and keep conveniently free therefrom during the day, so as to allow citizens to use the sidewalks in an easy, safe and commodious manner.”

☆ **The tennis courts are getting resurfaced in 2025!** The SWNA Board is working with the contractor to finalize the plans, but the work is tentatively scheduled for late May/early June. *Further information will come out before the courts will be closed.*
